THE SAN DIEGO TRAFFICKING PREVENTION COLLECTIVE PROGRAMS



PROTECT

PROTECT (Prevention Organized To Educate Children on Trafficking) is a holistic classroom education program that provides teachers and students with a comprehensive understanding of the dangers and signs of human trafficking and exploitation. Online or in-person staff training, instructional resources, and curriculum are available to teachers in elementary, middle, and high school. PROTECT helps teachers identify vulnerable students and connect them to the appropriate resources.

PROJECT ROOTS

Project ROOTS is an after-school program that addresses the root causes of gender-based violence, exploitation, and unhealthy relationships through group mentoring and social emotional learning. As a primary prevention program, it aims to build protective factors in elementary and middle school youth through the three central themes of empathy, equality, and empowerment.



KNOW MORE

KNOW MORE is a human trafficking awareness and prevention in-school assembly for middle and high school students. The program is lived experience expert led and provides a drama-based interactive training to support participants to recognize the red flags and vulnerabilities around trafficking and to know how to take action to prevent it.





DID YOU KNOW?

Sex trafficking is an \$810 million dollar industry

The average age of entry into sex trafficking is 16 years old

90% of high schools researched across the county reported cases of sex trafficking

The San Diego Trafficking Prevention Collective (SDPTC) is a multistage educational program that combines:

- Early childhood education
- Participatory theatre
- Age-appropriate classroom-based curriculum

All in an effort to decrease the number of children involved in human trafficking in San Diego.

Programs are **FREE** to all San Diego County Public schools.
